Students learn about the ways in which one can become a citizen of the United States and what that role means.

I-Civics WebQuest “Immigration and Citizenship”	In this web quest, students explore “coming to America.” They peek at the history of immigration, learn some reasons why people migrate and what attracts them to America, and look at the naturalization process. There they will see the assigned work and start. There are 11 pages in this webquest, each page has a question or questions that need to be answered using the link provided under the image on the page. Students will type their responses in the text box provided, making sure to click on the “Respond” option to lock in their work.</p>
