

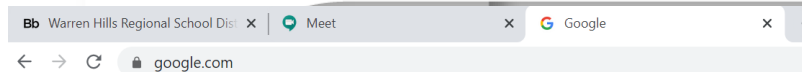
Troubleshooting Guide

GOOGLE MEET

If you are experiencing issues with Google Meet at home, here are some troubleshooting steps that may improve your video conferencing experience.

Close tabs

Reducing the number of Chrome tabs can free device resources for video conferencing.

Reducing and minimizing the number of devices connected to your home network can free up bandwidth for video conferencing.

Leaving and entering the Google Meet will re-establish the connection and may result in better performance.
